A right to the jaw floored Marcune, who barely made it to his feet before the ten count. He was unsteady when he rose, prompting the referee to stop the bout. The two boxers had been trading left hooks in the 8th round, prior to the knockout, with Marcune being hurt by a left hook shortly before being floored. The fight was close in the early rounds, with Marcune using his reach advantage, landing left-right combos, while Berrios scored with hooks. This bout opened the 1956 boxing season.
